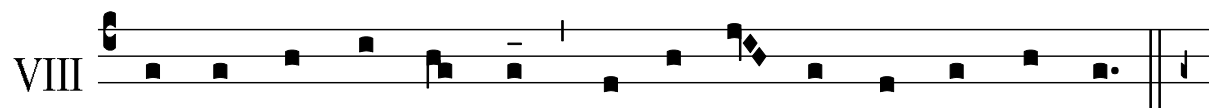
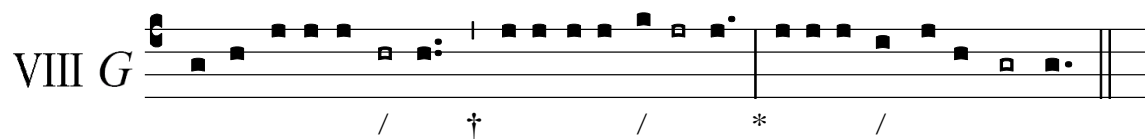

Psalm 104:1-2, 5-6, 10, 12, 13-14, 24, 35



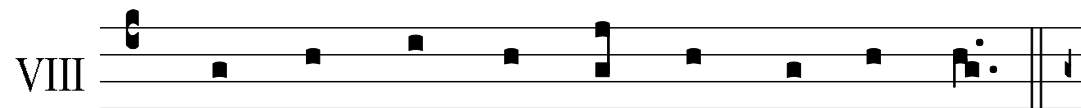
Lord, send out your Spir - it, and re - new the face of the earth.



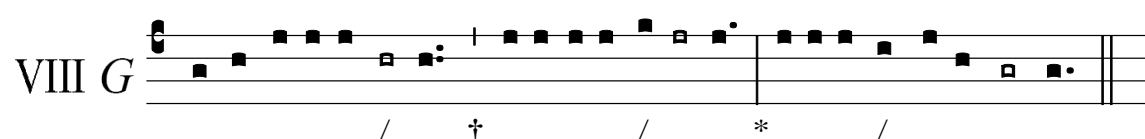
1. *Bless the Lord, O / my soul! †*

You are my in - her - i - tance, O Lord.



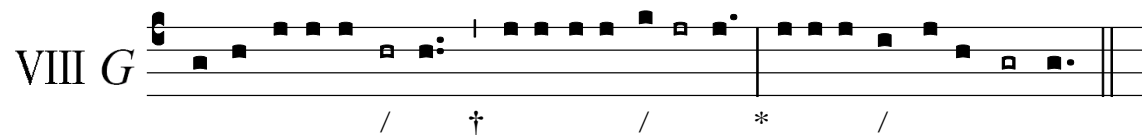
1. *O Lord*, my allotted portion and / **my** cup, *

Exodus 15:1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 17-18



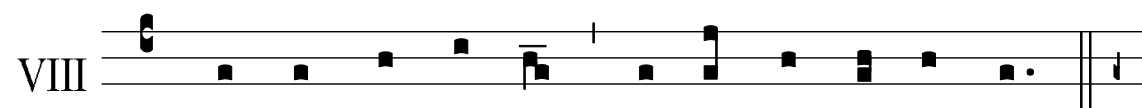
Let us sing to the Lord; he has co-ver'd him-self in glo-ry.



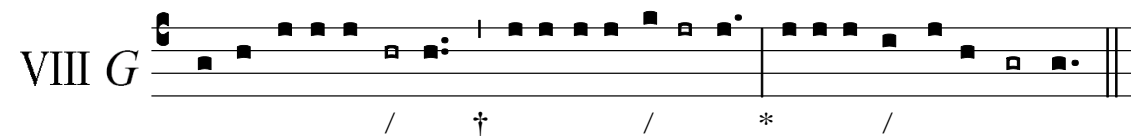
1. *I will* sing to the Lord, for he is gloriously tri/**umphant**; *

Psalms 30:2, 4, 5-6, 11-12, 13



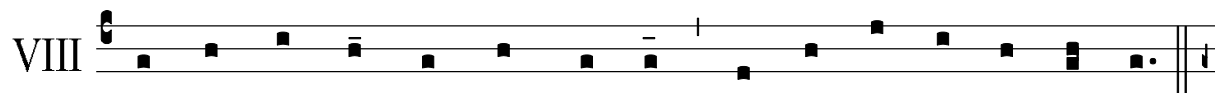
I will praise you, Lord, for you have res-cued me.



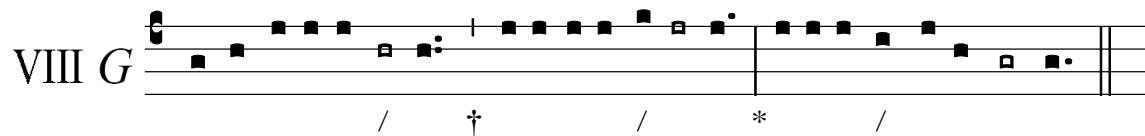
1. *I will* extol you, O Lord, for you / **drew** me clear *

Isaiah 12:2-3, 4, 5-6



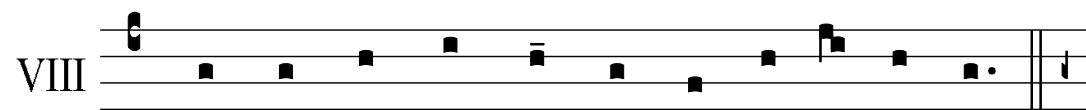
You will draw wa - ter joy - ful - ly from the springs of sal - va - tion.



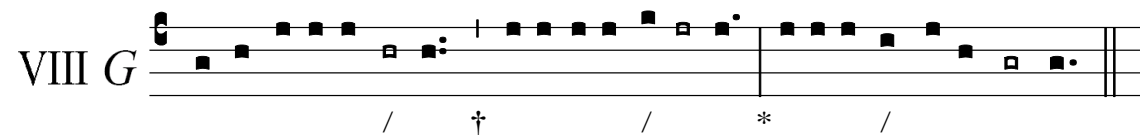
1. *God* indeed is my / **savior**; *
